Art Scholarship Contest Guidelines ~ 2019

- This portion of the contest is open to all students enrolled in grades 9 – 12 as of February 1, 2019. In the case of home schooled students, the year the student will enter college will be used to determine eligibility.
- There are several angles you can approach this from – Abortion, Euthanasia, Infanticide, or Stem Cell Research. This year’s theme is **“Loving Hearts & Saving Lives.”**
- Once art pieces are submitted to Right to Life of Southwest Indiana, they become sole property of Right to Life. All participants must be willing to sign a release form.
- Students submitting art work must adhere to the guidelines established below.
- Entries are due to the Right to Life of Southwest Indiana office by **Thursday, February 21, 2019 at 4 p.m.**

SIZE: **Mounted to a 20x30 poster board** (points will be deducted if your art piece is not mounted on the size requested)

ACCEPTABLE MEDIA:

Any 2 dimensional work on-

Paper or canvas

Photography

Prints

Low Relief Collage

Paint, Colored Pencils, Markers, Crayons or Pencil

Pastels – must be sprayed & covered with a loose clear plastic

***ALL** artwork must have a clearly printed contest label securely attached to the back.

*Winners will be announced at the Oratory Contest on February 28, 2019. Students who have entered the Art Contest are not required to attend, but may do so if they wish.
