January 24, 2020 will be the 47th March for Life. Right to Life of Southwest Indiana, Inc. is organizing a bus trip to the March for Life in Washington, D.C. again this year as we continue our efforts to protect the right to life of each and every innocent human being, born and preborn. Will you join us?

The 14th Amendment protects the right of a “person” to life and to the equal protection of the laws. In *Roe v. Wade*, the Supreme Court stated that if the personhood of the unborn child were established, the pro-abortion case “collapses, for the fetus’ right to life is then guaranteed by the Amendment.”

The Texas law challenged in *Roe* forbade abortion except to save the life of the mother. The *Roe* Court asked: “But if the fetus is a person who is not to be deprived of life without due process of law, and if the mother’s condition is the sole determinant, does not the Texas exception appear to be out of line with the Amendment’s command?”

The late, Nellie Gray, founder of the D.C. March for Life, argued that a ‘pro-life’ law is a bad law if it ends with the words, “and then you can kill the baby.”

Any legislation that requires a waiting period, consent, an ultrasound, etc. implies that after these conditions are met the baby can be killed.

- We hold these truths to be self-evident: That all human beings are created equal and are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable rights, among which is the right to life; and therefore:
- The right to life of each human being shall be preserved and protected by every human being in the society and by the society as a whole, and
- The life of each human being shall be preserved and protected from that human being’s biological beginning when the father’s sperm fertilizes the mother’s ovum, and
- The life of each human being shall be preserved and protected from the biological beginning through the natural continuum of that human being’s life by all available ordinary means and reasonable efforts, and
- The life of each human being shall be preserved and protected to the same extent as the life of each and every other human being regardless of state of health or condition of dependency, and
- When there is any doubt that there exists a human being’s life to preserve and protect, such doubt shall be resolved in favor of the existence of a human being, and
- When two or more human beings are in a situation in which their lives are mutually endangered, all available ordinary means and reasonable efforts shall be used to preserve and protect the life of each and every human being so endangered:
- WHEREFORE, Pursuant to these Principles, we recommend and urge the adoption of a Mandatory Human Life Amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America.
