Art Scholarship Contest Guidelines ~ 2021

- This portion of the contest is open to all students enrolled in grades 9 – 12 as of February 1, 2021. In the case of home-schooled students, the year the student will enter college will be used to determine eligibility.
- There are several angles you can approach this from – Abortion, Euthanasia, Infanticide, or Stem Cell Research. This year’s theme is “**Every Child Has a Purpose in Life.**”
- Once art pieces are submitted to Right to Life of Southwest Indiana, they become sole property of Right to Life. All participants must be willing to sign a release form.
- Students submitting art work must adhere to the guidelines established below.
- Entries are due to the Right to Life of Southwest Indiana office by **Thursday, February 11, 2021 at 4 p.m.**

SIZE: **Mounted to a poster board** (points will be deducted if your art piece is not mounted on the size requested)

ACCEPTABLE MEDIA:

Any 2-dimensional work on-
Paper or canvas
Photography
Prints
Low Relief Collage
Paint, Colored Pencils, Markers, Crayons, Charcoal or Pencil
Pastels – must be sprayed & covered with a loose clear plastic

***ALL** artwork must have a clearly printed contest label securely attached to the back.
