

# 2021 Elementary and Middle School Poster Contest

## Purpose of contest:

The *Right to Life of Southwest Indiana* elementary and middle school poster contest is to promote the artistic abilities of students as it relates to pro-life issues.

## Contest Theme:

The theme of the art contest is "Every Child Has a Purpose in Life."

## Contest Guidelines:

The contest is open for all children grades Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

One entry per student.

Finished poster size should be landscape and can range from 8 1/2" x 11" to 11"x14"

Artwork must be original. Posters must be freehand and cannot include pictures or computer generated drawing.

Words may be used.

Each poster will be evaluated on: originality, interpretation of theme and presentation of pro life message, artistic ability and overall effect.

The poster must reflect an unequivocally pro-life position. (Pro-life means affirming that all innocent human life from conception until to natural death is precious and must be protected.)

Posters must be turned in to the *Right to Life of Southwest Indiana* office by **Friday, March 19, 2021 no later than 3:00 p.m.**

Posters must have a completed information form attached.

Posters cannot be returned.

Upon submission, all artwork becomes the property of *Right to Life of Southwest Indiana*.

## Contest Awards:

There are three age categories:

Kindergarten - 2<sup>nd</sup> grade

3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> grade

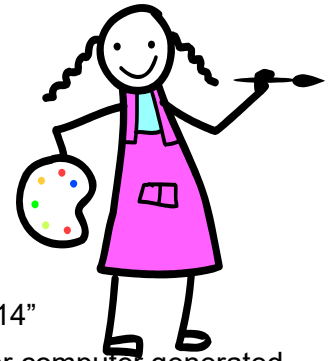
6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> grade
